


Richmond Village Beacon

- After students attend <u>60 hours</u> of instruction and pass a practice test, we will pay for their GED Test
- The GED (General Education Development) preparation program offers multi-level classes that focus on the five main topic areas: math, language



arts/writing, social studies and science.

- Steck-Vaughn's Pre-GED and GED series provide the backbone to the GED curriculum, which is supplemented with reallife materials including newspapers and writing guides.
- The TABE assessment tool is used to diagnose the learners current knowledge base so the instructor can concentrate lessons on the information needed for the GED test.
